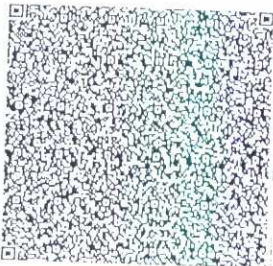



First party:


- The first party will associate with the colleges to undertake industrial Skill Awareness program and nuances of entrepreneurship.

The Parties shall not be liable to each other for failure or delay in the performance of any of its obligations under this Agreement for the time and to the extent such failure or delay is caused by riots, civil commotion, wars, hostilities between nations, government laws, orders regulations, embargos, action by the government(s) or any agency thereof act of God, storms, fires, accidents, strikes, sabotages, explosions, or other similar or different categories beyond the reasonable control of the respective parties to this Agreement In the event that either party is wholly or in part, prevented from or hindered in carrying out or observing any of the terms or conditions of this Agreement for any cause set forth hereinabove, such party shall give written notice to the other party by the most expeditious means as soon as possible after the occurrence of the cause relied on, given full particulars of the reason for such prevention or hindrances, and the party shall in good faith consult each other and take necessary measures for the resolution of the affairs so prevented or hindered.

Termination of Agreement



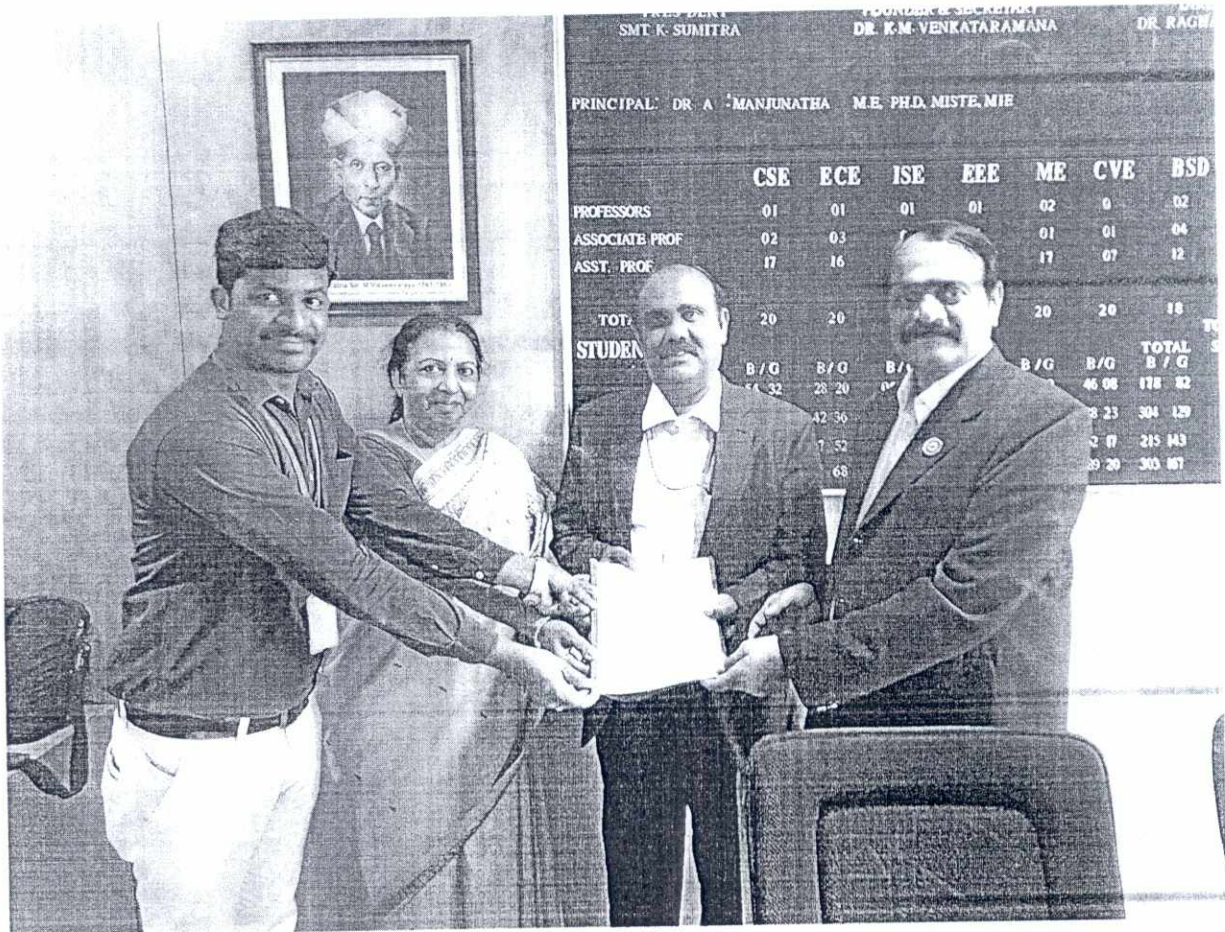
